We will highlight recent construction works, as well as what to expect in the upcoming months.

What we achieved over the Summer

We have carried out extensive drainage works in the car park and school perimeter, meaning that the areas will be less prone to flooding.

We have also part demolished Block 3, and created the concrete overslab for the new building.

The biggest change you will have seen is that the steel frame of the new building has now been installed. Over the Autumn and into Winter, you will see this transformed with concrete and bricks to look more and more like a new school



The footprint of the new building has been excavated to formation.

Upcoming activities over the Autumn

Over the Autumn, we will start installing brickwork, internal walls and services to the new building.

We have selected the bricks to match as closely as possible to the existing buildings' brickwork. Some of the school children have had a chance to sign some of the bricks before they have been fired, meaning that they will forever be a part of their new school building.
