


AYLMERTON

RESIDENTIAL VISIT

Aylmerton Field Study Centre, is set in an area of outstanding natural beauty in the heart of rural North Norfolk. Adjacent to the magnificent National Trust estate at Felbrigg, but just 15 minutes from the beach.



Aylmerton centre is a small, family run business established by Alan and Veronica Marett in 1989. Alan and Veronica are experienced teachers (Alan was a SEN specialist and Veronica was a Head teacher). They have over 25 years experience in running residential visits for all age groups.

Aylmerton is based in the original old school building although there are lots of different buildings all around the old school playground as well as a large playing field. Whilst we are there, the building we stay in is just for our school group and staff.

The dormitories are en- suite, we have our own dining room, classroom facilities and a large outdoor pavilion to use.

FINANCE



The approximate cost is **£225-£230**

This works out at approximately:
 £25 for coach transportation there, back and around the Aylmerton area.
 £183 for all accommodation, food, drink, snacks and activities (including 10 pin bowling, fire-making and pirate activities)
 £18 for a seal spotting boat tour

This price may fluctuate slightly due to the cost of the seal trip (they haven't announced their 2023 prices) however parents will pay no more than £230 and if it means we need to do something else instead of the seal boat tour then we will.

Payment can be made in full or in weekly/monthly installments. The full balance will need to be paid off by 24th March 2023 - one month before the trip takes place. The £30 deposit needs to be paid on ParentPay by 8th September 2022 to confirm your child's space.

Those who are eligible for Pupil Premium funding receive 10% off the total price of the trip.

Please encourage your child to help you pack.
 We do not know how kind the weather will be, so please pack for all eventualities!
A packed lunch and drink are required for the first day. Also an old towel or flannel is required to wipe down feet after beach walks.

Clothing

- Underwear and socks (not trainer socks)
- Single duvet cover
- Nightwear
- Trousers and jogging bottoms
- Warm tops and T-shirts
- Outdoor waterproof jacket (cagoules are best as they are easy to carry!)
- Clothes that you can wear in layers are a good idea so that it's easy to remove a layer.
- Hats and gloves (weather dependant)
- **An outfit or something to dress as a pirate! We may also use face paints for this activity so if your child is allergic please let us know.**

Footwear

Comfortable shoes or trainers are best. Wellingtons and slippers or indoor shoes (something to wear indoors is essential since communal areas are original stone floors.)
